Refraining from Accepting and Giving Gifts in the New Year or Any Other Occasions

The Minister of Education has announced Anti-Corruption intention and delivered the No Gift Policy of the Ministry of Education on International Anti-Corruption Day (Thailand) under the concept of “Ministry of Education, Transparency Not Resistant to Corruption” (MOE TRUST & Zero Corruption) Fiscal Year 2022 on December 15th, 2021. Raising awareness, stimulating and cultivating awareness of not accepting and resistant to corruption to personnel under the Ministry of Education including creating a good image of the Ministry of Education.

In order to comply with that intention, Ratsadanupraditanusorn School recognizes the importance of raising awareness of not accepting and not tolerate corruption. The prevention of corruption and misconduct are set measure as well as enhancing the values, attitudes, consciousness and behaviors of personnel in the affiliation to avoid acts that may affect the discretion or decision-making in the performance of duties which leads to discrimination or causing conflicts of interest. Therefore, Ratsadanupraditanusorn School has announced as follows:

1. Government teachers and educational personnel at all levels refrain from accepting gifts and gifts of and kind from performing duties from outsiders who come in contact and refrain from giving gifts and gifts of any kind to outsiders' visitors for all occasions, festivals and special occasions.
2. Government teachers and educational personnel at all levels must not seek to obtain unlawful gifts or benefits.
3. Congratulations, expressing good wishes, welcoming and expressing condolences on various occasions as usual conventionality should be used by signing in the greeting card, condolence card, or social media instead of giving things.
